

Fundraising for Teachers

There never seems to be enough money for schools. Many find themselves stretched to the limits or find it difficult to meet unforeseen expenditures.

This course offers alternatives to selling products to raise money. Helpful strategies as well as specific events and other vehicles for fundraising, including grant writing, will be shared. Specific suggestions based on the type of institution or grade level you represent will be presented directly to you.

Information on the Presenter

Dr. Charles Alberti started as a high school teacher and became an administrator, overseeing many fundraisers. Afterward, he became Chairman of the Education Department at a university in Illinois, where he wrote a Federal all-school grant which was funded. He moved on to become Director of Planning and Development of an eight hospital healthcare organization in Kansas, became certified by the National Society of Fundraising Executives (NSFRE), and became president of the Kansas chapter.

He served as one of 6 Deans for an international NSFRE international conference, which was attended by over 1,000 fundraisers. He coauthored a book titled "Money Makers: Special Events Fundraising", became VP of Development of a regional medical center in Illinois, and eventually moved back into academia at Bemidji State University where he served for 18 years.

In addition to teaching, he helped to raise funds for programs and scholarships within the department. Dr. Alberti is currently writing a book with the working title of "Fundraising in Hard Times."
